5. AIMS OF THE SCHOOL

6. ADMISSIONS

- Admissions are usually held in April for the next academic year for which registrations should be done on the prescribed form before the end of January.
- Candidates seeking admission to lower Nursery should complete 3½ years as on 31st March. Birth certificate should be produced from the Nagar.
- There will be an interaction between parents along with their child with the Principal. Admission will be based on the result of the entrance action depending on the number of seats available in the respective class.
- Parents / Guardians of the short listed candidates for admission are required to fill up a prescribed Admission Form and submit it duly signed to the office. No admission Form is issued to anyone to carry home. They should present a Transfer Certificate of their wards from the school last attended.
- Admission to classes UN to XII will depend on the number of seats vacant in each class and only after qualifying in written test.

7. FACILITIES AND RESOURCES

- BRB boasts a fleet of buses and Magic for exquisite transportation facilities within Badaun as well as places nearby. Reaching BRB, for the students is very easy and comfortable.
- We have a library endowed with the best books and help books. Our library enhances the students, quality of knowledge.
- BRB supports hygienic environment, hence has IRO filtered drinking water on every floor for the students.
- The school facilitates various activities, sports, arts, tours to develop an all round development among the student.
- The school is soon launching an indoor pool alongside an indoor court for sports and auditorium for conducting seminars, meetings etc.
- Smart class facilities to facilitate up to date questions as per CBSE Board.



8. ENGAGING WITH PARENTS

- PARENT TEACHER MEETING (PTM) is usually held after FA's and SA's and parents are notified through messages on cell phone beforehand.
- Parent / Guardians are requested to make use of this opportunity to meet the teachers of their wards to discuss the progress of their children.
- These meetings are contact meetings because the teachers and parents are together involved in the all round development of the child. There are occasions for the parents to let the teachers know that they are not merely paying fees but they also appreciate the efforts of the staff and their hard work towards their child.
- As far as possible all requests to meet the teachers to discuss the courses or anything pertaining to studies should be kept for PTM. In emergencies the Principal's prior permission is required to meet the staff.

9. STAFFING / LEARNING AND TEACHING

BRB insists on having the best faculty for various subjects. Our staff boasts for their subjective and class co-ordination abilities. They are trained to various classroom activities, so as to inculcate the changing pattern of education. The staff adheres to the school aims and objectives, and trains the students likewise. 15. GENERAL INFORMATION, ATTENDANCE / ABSENCE

- No leave of absence for the full day or a part thereof is granted except on previous written application and only for serious reasons. Absence without leave is liable to punishment at the discretion of the principal. All leave and absence should be recorded in the college diary.
- Repeated absence for seven calendar days without notification renders the students liable to dismissal.
- The student on returning to school must have the leave note signed by the parent / guardian in leave and absence record without this, the student will not be allowed to attend class.
- A minimum of 75% attendance of the working days is required for promotion. The student should be on time to college for the morning assembly. Disciplinary action will be taken against the late comers.
- A student who returns to college after a contagious or infectious disease should produce a Doctor's certificate of fitness permitting him / her to attend the school.
- All students are expected to attend college on the reopening day after vacation. No one is allowed to leave for vacation earlier than the closing day without prior permission of the principal.

3. OUR VISION AND VALUES

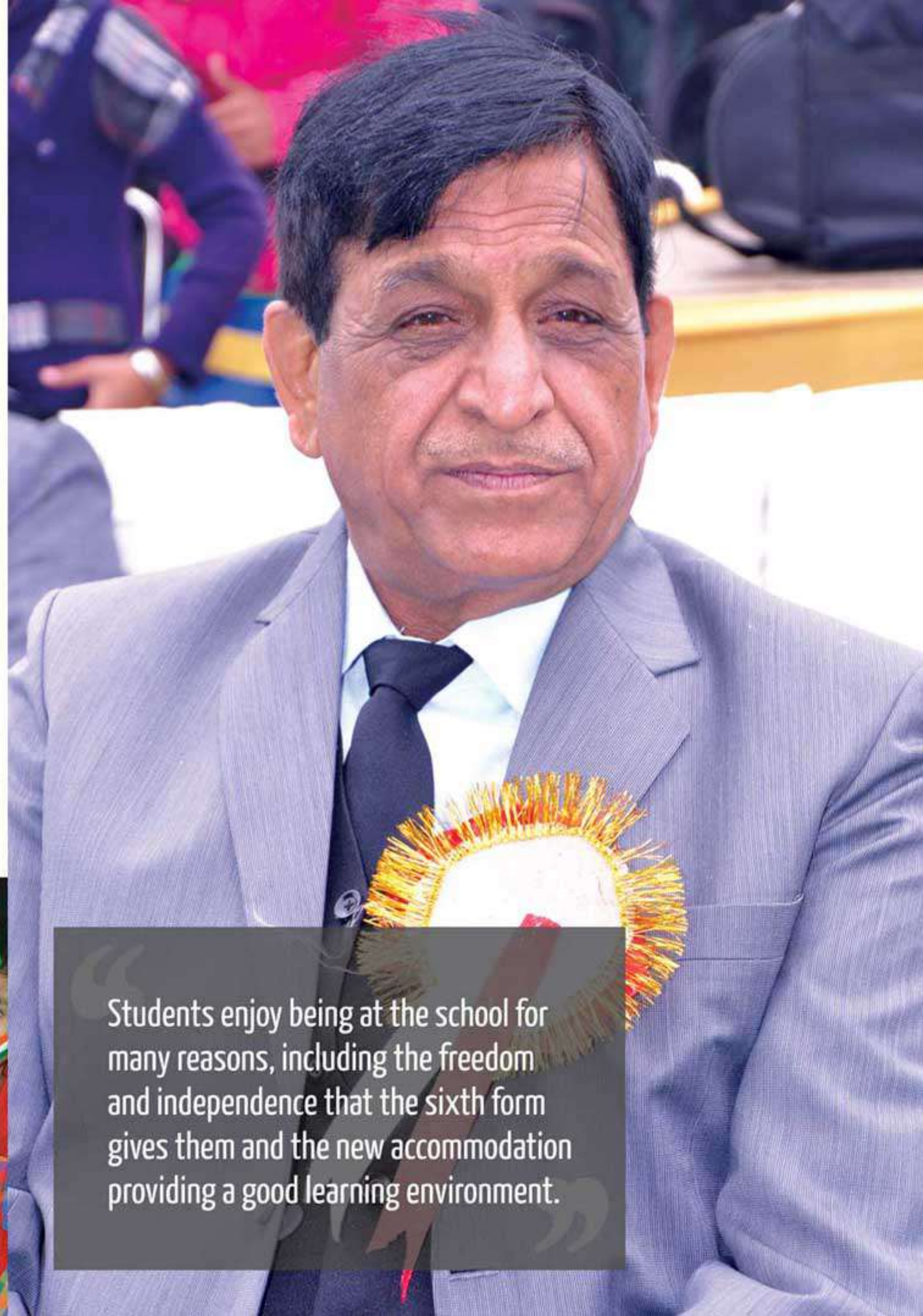
